Collecting other National Park passport stamps at the National Park and Monument visitors' centers can gain bonus points also. From the following list of Parks and Monuments, the first stamp is worth 50 points, the second 100, the third 150, etc. The list: Black Canyon of the Gunnison, Canyon of the Ancients, Colorado, Dinosaur, Florissant Fossil Beds, Great Sand Dunes, Hovenweep, Mesa Verde, RMNP Estes Park, RMNP Alpine Visitor Center, RMNP Grand Lake, and Yucca House. For each unique stamp you must also record your odometer reading and the time.
