It does not condone, nor will it tolerate, unsafe activities such as excessive speed, reckless motorcycle operation, riding while fatigued or otherwise impaired, the use of stimulants to maintain alertness, or any other activity that results in riders exceeding their personal limits. Any rider found to have engaged in these or other unsafe activities, as determined in the sole discretion of the” Two-Bits rally master “shall be subject to disqualification.”

F. Fuel Log**50 points**

Log entries must be made at each gas stop (including start and end) and must include the date, time, location, and odometer reading.

A receipt must accompany each fuel log entry and must include the date, time, location, and gallons.

Explanation of any problems encountered, for example, "At my third gas stop, the receipt did not include the date. I asked the attendant to sign his name and the date on the back but he refused, so I picked up one of their business cards."

If the time stamp on the gas receipt is way off actual time, you may try a different pump or different gas station, or also submit a photo of your GPS showing date, time, latitude and longitude.
